

Detailed Regulations on Website Disclosure of Final Manuscript of the Japanese Society of Agricultural Informatics

1. Authors may disclose electronic files of their own final manuscripts via the following websites.

- 1) Websites managed individually by authors
- 2) Websites of institutions to which authors belong (including institutional repositories)
- 3) Websites of institutions providing research fund assistance

2. The term “final manuscripts” refers to the manuscripts owned by authors who have undergone reviews and whose contribution has been permitted.

3. Upon disclosure, the following source information must be indicated (in any order).

- 1) Title
- 2) Name of author(s)
- 3) Name of academic journal
- 4) Publication volume number
- 5) Publication page
- 6) URL(s) of corresponding manuscripts on J-STAGE (only manuscripts contributed on J-STAGE)

4. In case that all of the terms and conditions through 1 to 3 above are satisfied, permission procedures for disclosure shall not be necessary.

5. Amendments to these Regulations shall be conducted by the Editorial Committee and shall be publicly announced after obtaining of the approval of the council of the Society.
